

**1) DO YOU NOT KNOW?**

*Isaiah 40:27-31 (NIV)*  
Do you not know? Have you not heard?  
The LORD is the everlasting God,  
the Creator of the ends of the earth.  
He will not grow tired or weary,  
and His understanding no one can fathom.  
He gives strength to the weary  
and increases the power of the weak.

Why do you say, O Jacob,

**3) HUMBLE YOURSELVES**

*1 Peter 5:6-11 (RSV)*  
Humble yourselves, therefore,  
under the mighty hand of God,  
that in due time He may exalt you.  
Cast all your anxieties on Him,  
for He cares about you.  
Be sober, be watchful.

Your adversary the devil prowls around  
like a roaring lion,  
seeking someone to devour.  
Resist him, firm in your faith,  
knowing that the same experience  
of suffering  
is required of your brotherhood  
throughout the world.

And after you have suffered  
a little while,  
the God of all grace,  
who has called you,  
to His eternal glory in Christ,  
will Himself restore, establish,  
and strengthen you.

**4) I KNOW THE PLANS**

*Jeremiah 29:11; Proverbs 3:5,6;*  
*Psalms 37:5,7a (TLB)*

**6) DO NOT THROW AWAY YOUR CONFIDENCE**

*Hebrews 10:35-39 (NIV)*  
Do not throw away your confidence;  
it will be richly rewarded.  
You need to persevere  
so that when you’ve done the will of God,

For in just a very little while,  
“He who is coming will come  
and will not delay.  
But my righteous one will live by faith.  
And if he shrinks back,  
I will not be pleased with him.”

But we are not of those who shrink back,  
we are not of those who are destroyed,  
but of those who believe and are saved,  
who believe and are saved... *(repeat)*

So do not throw away your confidence...

**7) THERE IS NO FEAR IN LOVE**

*1 John 4:18a; 2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV)*  
There is no fear in love.  
But perfect love drives out fear...  
for God did not give us a spirit of timidity,  
but a spirit of power, a spirit of love,  
and of self-discipline,  
a spirit of power, a spirit of love,

**8) I WILL PRAISE YOU, O LORD**

*Psalms 138:1-3 (NIV)*  
I will praise You, O Lord,  
with all my heart,  
before the “gods”  
I will sing Your praise.

**11) HIS GRACE IS SUFFICIENT**

*2 Corinthians 12:9,10 (NIV)*  
*Chorus:*  
His grace is sufficient for me,

Therefore I will boast  
all the more gladly  
about my weaknesses,  
so that Christ’s power may rest on me,

*James 1:17*  
*Music by Joanne Geeze*  
The wisdom from above is first pure,  
then peaceable, gentle, reasonable,  
full of mercy, and good fruit,  
unwavering, without hypocrisy.

**14) I WANT TO KNOW CHRIST**

*Philippians 3:7-14; Isaiah 53:2,3 (NIV)*  
But whatever was to my profit  
I now consider loss  
for the sake of Christ. What is more—  
I consider everything a loss  
compared to the surpassing greatness  
of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord,  
for whose sake I have lost all things.  
I consider them rubbish  
that I may gain Christ and be found in Him,  
not having a righteousness of my own  
that comes from the law,  
but that which is through faith in Christ—  
the righteousness that comes from God  
and is by faith...  
the righteousness that is by faith.

I want to know Christ. *I want to know Jesus,*  
and the power of His resurrection,  
I want to know Christ... Jesus,  
and the fellowship  
of sharing in His sufferings,  
I want to know Christ... *Jesus,*  
becoming like Him in His death,  
and so, somehow to attain  
to the resurrection from the dead.

He had no beauty or majesty  
to attract us to Him,  
nothing in His appearance  
that we should desire Him.  
He was despised and rejected by men,  
a man of sorrows,  
and familiar with suffering.  
Like one from whom men hide their faces,  
He was despised,  
and we esteemed Him not.

And the fellowship  
of sharing in His sufferings?...

Not that I have  
already obtained all this,  
or have already been made perfect,  
but I press on to take hold of that  
for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.  
Brothers, I do not consider myself  
yet to have taken hold of it.  
But one thing I do:  
Forgetting what is behind  
and straining toward what is ahead,  
I press on toward the goal  
to win the prize for which God  
has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.  
To win the prize for which God  
has called me heavenward in *Jesus Christ!*

**15) LET US FIX OUR EYES ON JESUS**

*Hebrews 12:1-3 (NIV)*  
Therefore, since we are surrounded  
by such a great cloud of witnesses,  
let us throw off everything that hinders  
and the sin that so easily entangles,  
and let us run with perseverance  
the race marked out for us.  
Let us fix our eyes on Jesus,  
the author and perfecter of our faith,  
who for the joy set before Him  
endured the cross, scorning its shame,  
and sat down at  
the right hand of the throne of God.  
Consider Him who endured  
such opposition from sinful men,  
so that you will not grow weary,  
weary and lose heart...  
So you will not lose heart.

**16) DO YOU NOT KNOW?**

**17) SING JOYFULLY**  
*Psalms 33:1-3 (NIV)*  
Sing joyfully to the Lord, you righteous;  
it is fitting for the upright to praise Him.  
Praise the Lord with the—  
with the harp; make music to Him on the  
ten-stringed lyre.  
Sing to Him a new song;  
play skillfully, and shout for joy. *(repeat)*

*Psalms 116:7 (NIV)*

**19) UNLESS THE LORD**

*Psalms 94:17-19; 117 (NIV)*

When anxiety was great within me,

*Psalms 143:1,8-10 (NIV)*  
Let the morning bring me word  
of Your unfailing love,  
for I have put my trust in You.  
Show me the way I should go,  
for to You I lift up my soul.  
Praise the Lord, all you nations;  
extol Him, all you peoples.  
For great is His love toward us,  
and the faithfulness of the Lord  
endures forever.

for to You I lift up my soul.

**21) WHOM HAVE I?**

*from Psalms 73:25, 26 (NIV-1978 version)*  
Whom have I in heaven but You?  
And being with You,  
I desire nothing on earth.  
I desire nothing.  
My flesh and heart may fail,  
but God is my strength  
and my portion forever,  
and my portion forever.  
May Your good Spirit  
lead me on level ground. *(repeat)*  
O Lord, hear my prayer,  
listen to my cry for mercy;

in Your faithfulness and  
Your righteousness,  
come to my relief.

**22) A WAY OUT**

*1 Corinthians 10:12,13 (NIV)*  
So, if you think you are standing firm,  
be careful that you don’t fall!  
No temptation has seized you  
except what is common to man.  
And God is faithful. He will not let you  
be tempted beyond what you can bear.  
But when you are tempted,  
He will also provide a way out  
so that you can stand up under it.

*Psalms 130 (NIV)*  
Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord;  
O Lord, hear my voice.  
Let Your ears be attentive

But with You there is forgiveness;  
therefore You are feared.  
I wait for the Lord, my soul waits,

Listen to my cry,  
for I am in desperate need;  
rescue me from those who pursue me,  
for they are too strong for me.

Submit yourselves, then, to God.  
Resist the devil,  
and he will flee from you.

**29) BLESSED ARE**

*Matthew 5:3-10 (NIV)*  
Blessed are the poor in spirit,  
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.  
Blessed are those who mourn,  
for they will be comforted.  
Blessed are the meek,  
for they will inherit the earth.  
Blessed are those who hunger  
and thirst for righteousness,  
for they will be filled.  
Blessed are the merciful,  
for they will be shown mercy.  
Blessed are the pure in heart,  
for they will see God.  
Blessed are the peacemakers,  
for they will be called sons of God,  
sons of God,  
Blessed are those who are persecuted  
because of righteousness,  
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

**30) I AM THE WAY**

*John 14:6; Isaiah 35:8a,9,10 (NIV)*
